

# Myanmar National Health Policy re-formulation (2020-2030)

## Purpose

The overall Goal of the national Health Policy is: “Attain the highest possible level of health and well-being of entire population at all ages by 2030, in a responsive manner”.

## Objective

The overall objective of the policy is to attain universal coverage of critical services that positively contribute to the realization of the policy goal. The essential health services attaining the needs of the population should reach to all, leaving no one behind, adhering to objective quality standards and applying evidence-informed interventions through resilient health system. The policy objectives are defined as follows:

### *a. Health Services*

- i. Improved reproductive, maternal, new-born, child and adolescent health services;
- ii. Reduced prevalence of communicable diseases;
- iii. Reversed the rising burden of non-communicable diseases and mental disorders;
- iv. Efficient emergency preparedness and response;
- v. Accessed to essential health care, inclusive of traditional medicine services;
- vi. Minimized exposure to health risk factors;
- vii. Realized exercise is health;

### *b. Intersectoral Collaboration*

- i. Reduced malnutrition;
- ii. Sustained water safety, sanitation, hygiene and food safety;
- iii. Sustained occupation health services;
- iv. Sustained environmental pollution control and climate change services

### *c. Partnerships in health*

- i. Strengthened community participation;
- ii. Strengthened PPP;
- iii. Strengthened partnership with international partners in health.
