# National Commitments on Family Planning

- ❑ FP 2020 Commitment at the International Conference on Family Planning in November 2013.
  - To Increase CPR from 41 percent to 50 percent by 2015 and above 60 percent by 2020.
  - To Reduce unmet need to less than 10 percent by 2015 (from 12 percent in 2013).
- ❑ Country Commitment at ICPD 25 in November 2019
  - Zero preventable maternal death, morbidity and disability by 2030 and
  - Zero unmet need for FP by 2030

- ❑ Support for RHCLS is one of the activities

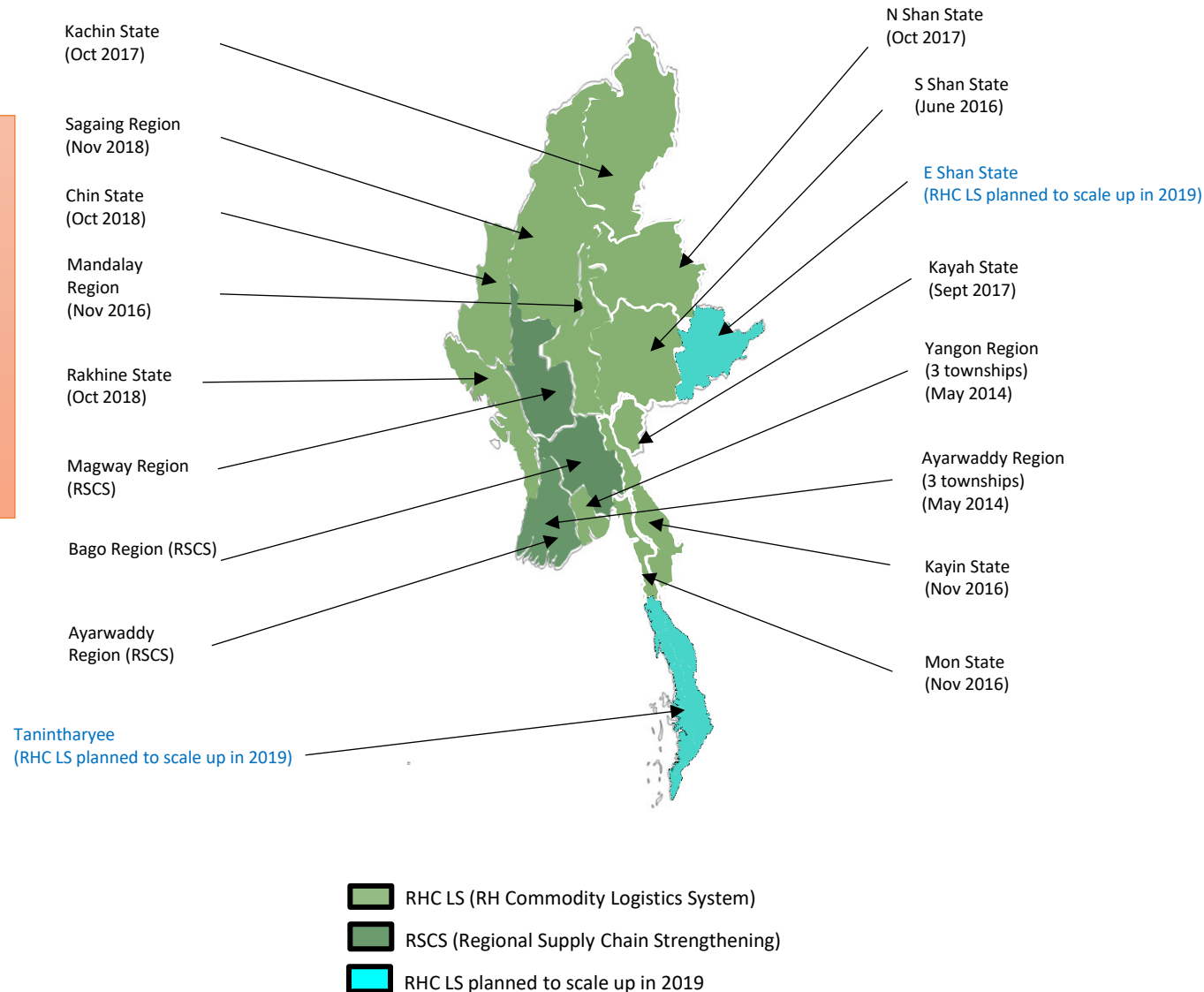
## 3. UNFPA Core Fund
