Objectives of the workshop

Group 5 Gender and Gender-based Violence





Expected outcomes of workshop

- Participants know what implementation research is
- 5-6 research questions per research areas (a total of 25 to 30 research questions) will be prioritized
- Action plan for prioritized research questions



Development of Action Plan for Prioritized Research Questions

- Who will do what research and by what time it will be finished with what funding sources will be identified
- The process will:
 - Align research with the National Strategic Plan
 - Help allocate limited funding to areas of greatest need
 - Guide a more effective epidemic response





Guiding Principles

- Country-driven
- Builds on existing and previous National Research Agenda
- Closely coordinates with ongoing efforts and national priorities
- Ensures engagement of multiple stakeholders across domains
